1. To begin the application process, please click the APPLY button within the Apply section of Breck's website. This link will take you to our application portal where you can create an application record for your child.

Once your account is created, parent(s)/guardian(s) are responsible for completing the family information, and family statement. Prospective students for grades 5-12 are responsible for completing a student statement.

- 2. The application will ask for the names and email addresses of the teacher(s) who will be providing Breck with a recommendation.

 Required recommendations are noted below:
 - Preschool 4th grade: one recommendation from a current teacher
 - 5th Grade 8th Grade: two recommendations; one English and one Math teacher
 - 9th-12th Grade: three recommendations; one English, one Math, and one teacher or coach of choice

Our application system will send an email to the recommenders you have listed prompting them to complete a recommendation. We recommend completing this step in advance of our application deadline.

- 3. Provide your child's current school with the transcript release form (grades fifth through twelfth only).
- 4. Schedule your applicant conference and campus visit. Visit requirements vary based on the grade of entry and are as follows:
 - Preschool/Kindergarten: Parent Conference with Student Assessment and a separate Playgroup
 - Grades 1-12: Parent Conference and Student Day Visit
- 5. For applicants to grades 5-12, schedule applicant testing on select dates. Available dates can be scheduled within the admissions calendar, which is linked from the applicant portal and Breck's website.

Testing runs from 9:00-Noon on the following Saturdays: December 7, January 11, February 8, and February 22.

6. If applying for financial assistance, complete the financial aid application by February 15, 2020. Financial aid decision will be released with admissions decision.
